



## 60.5430a What definitions apply to this suppart? (page 35933)

*<u>Certifying official</u>* means one of the following:

(1) For a corporation: A president, secretary, treasurer, or vice-president of the corporation in charge of a principal business function, or any other person who performs similar policy or decision-making functions for the corporation, or a duly authorized representative of such person if the representative is responsible for the overall operation of one or more manufacturing, production, or operating facilities applying for or subject to a permetar either:

(i) The facilities employ more than 250 persons or have gross annual sales to appenditures exceeding \$25 million (in second quarter 1980 dollars); or

(ii) The Administrator is notified of such delegation of authority prior to the experise of that avalancy. The Administrator reserves the right to evaluate such delegation;

(2) For a partnership (including but not limited to general partnerships and including and including all partnerships) or sole proprietorship: A general partner or the proprietor, respectively. If a general partner is a corporation, the provisions of page partner (1) of this definition on the provision of page partner is a corporation.

(3) For a municipality, State, Federal, or other public agency: Either a principal executive interest ranking elected official. For the purposes of this part, a principal executive officer of a Federal agency includes the chief executive officer having responsibility for the overall corrations of a principal geographic unit of the agency (*e.g.*, a Regional Administrator of EPA); or

(4) For affected facilities:

(i) The designated representative in so for a action, standards, requirement, or prohibitions under title IV of the Clean Air Act or the regulations promulgated thereunder are concerned; or

(ii) The designated representative for purposes under part 60.
